#### Vacuum Package

- Two oil-less rotary claw type vacuum pumps with inlet filter and isolation valve for each
- ASME coded vacuum receiver with bypass and manual drain
- Duplex control panel with automatic lead/lag controls
- All components completely pre-piped and pre-wired to single point service connections
- · Vibration isolation mountings
- Liquid tight conduit, fittings and junction boxes for all control and power wiring
- All interconnecting piping and wiring is completed and operationally tested prior to shipment

## Vacuum Pump

- Oil-less rotary claw pump
- Direct-driven through a shaft coupling
- · Air-cooled
- End (ultimate) vacuum = 28" Hg
- Dry-running, with two claw-type, non-contacting rotors
- · Sealing fluid not required
- Virtually maintenance-free operation
- High discharge temperature switch
- Oil change required at approximately 5,000 operating hour intervals in the gearbox only
- Built-in, anti-suck-back valve mounted at the pump inlet
- 2 micron inlet filter for removal of particulates

## **Vacuum Motor**

- NEMA rated
- C-face
- TEFC
- 208 or 230/460V 3-phase

## Vibration Isolation System

- Vacuum and motor fully isolated from the package base by means of a four-point, heavy duty, isolation system
- Minimum of 95% isolation efficiency
- Optional seismically restrained isolators at an additional cost

#### Intake/Discharge Piping

- Vacuum pumps are connected to a common manifold and piped to a horizontal receiver
- Inlet check valve on each pump
- Inlet isolation valve on each pump
- Flexible connectors between pumps and manifold
- Flexible connectors for inlet and discharge connections
- Discharge flex connection shipped loose

#### Vacuum Receiver

- Horizontal orientation with integrally mounted bypass and manual drain
- ASME Code stamped
- National Board Certified
- Rated for a minimum 200 PSIG design pressure
- Vacuum gauge
- Manual drain


# Oxygen Compatibility
